

## Ir + a + infinitive

Yo voy – I'm going

Tú vas – you're going

El, ella, Ud. va – he/she are going

Nosotros vamos – we are going

Vosotros vais – you guys are going

Ellos, ellas, Uds. van – they're going

Adding 'a' + infinitive **to make a future tense**

**INFINITIVE** = Any verb that ends in –er, –ir, –ar

Some form of 'ir' + a + infinitive

Yo form 1. Yo voy a hablar. I'm going to speak.

Tú form 2. Tú vas a hablar. You're going to speak.

El/ella va 3. El/ella va a hablar. He/She is going to speak.

Nosotros form 4. Nosotros vamos a hablar. We're going to speak.

Vosotros form 5. Vosotros vais a hablar. You guys are going to speak.

Ellos, ellas form 6. Ellos/ellas van a hablar. They're going to speak.

Change the infinitive, change the meaning of the sentence

1. Yo voy a hablar. I'm going to speak.
2. Yo voy a bailar. I'm going to dance.
3. Yo voy a leer. I'm going to read.
4. Tú vas a leer. You're going to read.
5. El va a leer. He's going to read.
6. Ellos van a leer. They're going to read.
7. Ellos van a bailar. They're going to dance.
8. Nosotros vamos a dar una fiesta. We're going to throw a party.
9. Vosotros vais a dar una fiesta. You guys are going to throw a party.
10. Julio va a bailar. Julio is going to dance.
